There are 3 major tentative Agreements (TA). The COLA is retro and substantial. Meal reimbursement is substantially higher than the current \$6. Bereavement is currently 1 day for a local event and 3 days for an event where much travel is required. We are to increase the number of days. Many others were discussed. We have started small table negotiations(L17 and City). Once all are complete what contract will go to membership for approval. Karen has suggested we use in person voting at various locations and times to have more interaction with our membership and to celebrate the hard work that has been accomplished.

Officers' Reports

Darren mentioned that in the near future an all shop steward event will be held at PROTEC 17 hall, likely post contract.

Good of the Order

PROTEC 17 will be at the PRIDE parade June 30th. Steward Acadamy will be June 25th.
