Now that you're vaccinated, a few things to remember!





After your vaccination, you will receive a vaccination card. Remember, you are fully vaccinated two weeks after your final dose of vaccine. Some vaccines require one dose and some two.



Your vaccination card will show:

- Your name and date of birth
- Which vaccine you got
- The date or dates you got your shot/s



Keep your vaccination card safe!

- Keep this card in a safe place
- Take a photo of the card
- Store the card in a waterproof container

If you have lost or damaged your vaccination card, here's what you can do:

- Check with your health care provider (or website) for your immunization record, or
- Follow the instructions on the Oregon Health Authority Immunization Resources page https://www.oregon.gov/oha/PH/PREVENTIONWELLNESS/VACCINESIMMUNIZATION/GETTINGIMMUNIZED/Pages/ImmRecords.aspx (may take 5 days to get record), or
- Call 211 for help in languages other than English
