2024 Scholarship Program

The Professional and Technical Employees Local 17 (PROTEC17) Scholarship Program will award two \$3,000 scholarships to the child, grandchild, or dependent of an active member (a dues-paying member in good standing) who wishes to continue their education beyond high school at a college, university or technical institute. One scholarship will be for an individual starting his/her/their first year at college; the other award will be for an individual enrolling into any subsequent year of college. The scholarship is designed to be used in the year awarded and may not be used retroactively. The award will be sent directly to the financial aid office of the school upon satisfactory proof that the student is enrolled in a course of study.

Application Procedure

To apply, the following items must be submitted:

- Completed Scholarship Application form (next page)
- 2. Completed Supplemental Information (Items 1-3, described on pages 1-2)
- 3. Completed Labor Essay (Item 4, described on page 3)
- 4. Official transcript from high school (unofficial transcripts will not suffice)
- 5. Official transcript from college, university or technical institute (if applicable)
- 6. Two (2) letters of recommendation

The deadline to apply is July 31, 2024.

Please note: All application items must be received by 5 p.m. on Wed., July 31, 2024. Incomplete applications may be disqualified.

Application Scoring

The application will be reviewed, verified, and scored by PROTEC17's Communications Director. The essay will be evaluated and judged anonymously by members of the PROTEC17 Executive Board.

Scoring will be on the following basis:

Academic Achievement: 20%
Community Service, Volunteering, Extracurricular Activities, Awards: 20%
Educational Plans and Goals: 20%
Essay: 40%

The winners will be notified by phone, email and/or mail. The names and photos of the winners will be publicized in PROTEC17's magazine, *Insight*, on our website and our social media channels. PROTEC17 reserves the right to publish the winner's name and essay. In case of a tie (more than one individual with identical high scores), the winner will be selected by a secondary panel of evaluators. This decision shall be final. In the event there are no qualified applicants, or the applicants do not meet the specified criteria, PROTEC17 reserves the right to make no scholarship award.
