MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

By and between

THE CITY OF SEATTLE

and

SIGNATORY UNIONS

CITY FLEET VEHICLE TELEMATICS

BACKGROUND

The City of Seattle will activate or install Vehicle Telematics ("VT") systems on all City owned and/or operated vehicles and equipment to support best practices for municipal fleet management.

By executing this Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA"), the parties affirmatively acknowledge that they have fully met their bargaining obligations regarding implementation of Vehicle Telematics systems as described above, and the Parties agree to the terms detailed below. The City further affirms that, should it wish to make non-emergent substantive changes to the terms of this MOA, it will provide advanced notice to the signatory Unions and meet its bargaining obligation, if any.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Parties signatory to this Agreement agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Data captured by VT systems allows the City to more effectively deploy field staff and crews, to obtain real time location data used to coordinate and direct employees' work assignments and in the event of an accident or injury or theft, to allow for mapping and routing of employees for safety, accuracy, and efficiency, to improve field staff and crew productivity by improving the planning and scheduling of daily assignments, to schedule and deploy staff in emergency situations, to capture data for purposes of vehicle and equipment maintenance, department financial accounting practices, and capital improvement planning, and to enhance the overall efficiency and effectiveness of municipal services.
- 2) VT systems shall be installed and activated on all City fleet assets and every City owned/operated vehicles and equipment. This MOA does not cover City vehicles used solely and exclusively by employees of the Seattle Police Department, because those vehicles are not within the representational scope of the undersigned unions.
- 3) Data collected by the VT systems and used by the employer shall be relevant to the City's operational functions.

- 4) The City agrees that the purpose of capturing VT data is not to monitor an individual employee's job performance on an ongoing, day-to-day basis, but for the reasons expressed above.
- 5) The City agrees not to use VT data as the sole basis for disciplining an employee whose position is represented by one of the signatory Unions. The City may rely on VT data in the course of an investigation or to confirm or disprove an allegation.
- 6) Should the City receive a Public Disclosure Request ("PDR") for VT data, the City shall provide notice to employee(s) who are specifically named.
